Fundamental British Values

The Gosport and Fareham Multi Academy Trust is a Trust which serves its community; staff, pupils and students recognise the multi-cultural, multi faith and ever-changing nature of the United Kingdom, understands and embraces our role in ensuring groups or individuals are treated with mutual respect.
